20	MS THOMAS: Thank you, Commissioner Gibson. Over the last eight days of Uhia te
21	Māramatanga, this public hearing, we have heard from 23 survivors and whānau members.
22	As we close this hearing this afternoon, we would like to acknowledge the very many
23	disabled survivors, Deaf survivors, and survivors who have experienced mental distress,
24	who have also provided evidence to this Royal Commission through their private sessions
25	and through witness statements.
26	We would also like to welcome and encourage any more survivors who may like to
27	come forward and engage with us.
28	We would also like to acknowledge the disabled survivors, Deaf survivors, and
29	survivors who have experienced mental distress who have previously given evidence
30	during the last three years of the Royal Commission's public hearings. We have compiled
31	some survivor quotes from survivor evidence at these previous hearings and we've put them
32	into a video which we will play now as part of the close of this public hearing.

1	As with all of the evidence that we have heard throughout the last eight days, I need
2	to say that it is distressing, and some people may find this video hard to watch. I would ask
3	for it to be played now.
